Our Prayer 2025

The Logo represents humanity from the four corners of the earth. They are embraced by one another to indicate the solidarity and brotherhood that must unite peoples. It is to be noticed that the first in line is holding on to the cross.

It is useful to observe the waves that are underneath, and that are in motion to indicate that the pilgrimage of life does not always move in calm waters.

The lower part of the Cross is prolonged by turning into an anchor-metaphor for hope- it situates itself in the wave motion.

Anchor of Hope is the name given, in maritime jargon, to the reserve anchor, used to perform emergency maneuvers and to stabilize the ship during storms.

The image shows how the pilgrim's journey is not an individual affair, but a communal one with the imprint of a growing dynamism that tends more and more toward the Cross.

The Cross is not static at all, but also dynamic, bending toward humanity. Finally, with the color green, the Motto of Jubilee 2025, Peregrinantes in Spem - Pilgrims of Hope.

«We can justly consider that the future of humanity lies in the hands of those who are strong enough to provide coming generations with reasons for living and hoping» (Gaudium et Spes, 31).

What hope is sustainable in youth education? Sustainable hope is "the soul of education as of the whole of life" (*Spe Salvi*). But this sustainable hope, yesterday as today, is undermined and threatened on several fronts, in particular, by the increase of distrust among educators, parents and teachers: "at the root of the crisis of education there is in fact a crisis of trust in life" (*idem*).

Fr. Anthony and Fr. Mark Cavanis, priests and educators, testified with perseverance and courageous contentment the love for life and Christian formation of youth. By means of a bold sustainable hope deposited in the education of the hearts and minds of young people, they made visible the great need of the human being which is to receive and communicate life.

The education of the youth, is "a work that must be conducted and administered by enthusiastic workers all animated by a true spirit of fervent charity" (from Fr. Mark's last discourse, 16.7.1853). Workers who would be "fathers of the beloved youth". The charity that animated the entire life and hope of the Cavanis was the charity that comes from God, because "God is Love".

For the right to an education.

Let us pray for migrants, refugees and those affected by war, that their right to an education, which is necessary to build a better world, might always be respected.

Cavanis:

The Congregation of the Schools of Charity, in front of the shortcomings and difficulties of education and the dangers that the youth encounter in their growth, "was founded primarily to exercise towards young people the duties as of fathers, and not just simply being their teachers" in support of the educational action of the family, through its school or other initiatives which follow the project of the Founders (Constitutions and Norms, 2).

Heart of Jesus, may the Eucharist be the centre of the life of your priests.

Sebruary

For vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

Let us pray that the ecclesial community might welcome the desires and doubts of those young people who feel a call to serve Christ's mission in the priesthood and religious life.

Cavanis:

The Religious generously devote themselves to pastoral activities, especially for developing pastoral plans for family and youth, to the formation for consecrated life and priesthood (Constitutions and Norms, 60/b).

Heart of Jesus, may the good life of your ministers be a pleasant offering to the heavenly Father.

March

For families in crisis.

Let us pray that broken families might discover the cure for their wounds through forgiveness, rediscovering each other's gifts, even in their differences

Cavanis:

The Cavanis method and educational style involve the continuous presence of the "father" educator. In this way the Cavanis works are transformed into a family, where relationships are lived in an authentic and constant way, to reach the mind and, above all, the heart of young people (Cavanis Educational Project, 22).

Heart of Jesus, your elected ones may be an irradiation of your presence among men.

April

For the use of the new technologies.

Let us pray that the use of the new technologies will not replace human relationships, will respect the dignity of the person, and will help us face the crises of our times.

Cavanis:

The new communication technologies should be used as tools for evangelization, for knowledge of the problems of the world and of young people, to share the joys and concerns of our distant religious families; but let them never replace personal relationships.

Heart of Jesus, fill your ministers with holiness and charity that they can operate according to your Heart.



For working conditions.

Let us pray that through work, each person might find fulfilment, families might be sustained in dignity, and that society might be humanized

Cavanis:

May the Cavanis Religious and Collaborators be committed to educating young people with particular sensitivity to respect for the dignity of every person. the Church insists that the dignity of every human person, precisely because it is intrinsic, remains "in all circumstances". The recognition of this dignity cannot be contingent upon a judgment about the person's ability to understand and act freely (*Dignitas infinita*, 24).

Heart of Jesus, guide with your hand the sacred ministers and inflame them with holy zeal for your glory.



That the world might grow in compassion.

Let us pray that each one of us might find consolation in a personal relationship with Jesus, and from his Heart, learn to have compassion on the world.

Cavanis:

Community life has as its goal fraternity, love and mutual service, according to the example of Jesus, for a greater availability to the pastoral ministry and charism. For this reason, [the Religious] avoid anything that may offend others or diminish the willingness to sanctification and to the apostolate (*Constitutions and Norms*, 10/a).

Heart of Jesus, may your priests deepen every day the gift they received.



For formation in discernment.

Let us pray that we might again learn how to discern, to know how to choose paths of life and reject everything that leads us away from Christ and the Gospel.

Cavanis:

Each religious humbly consider himself as always in on-going formation to reach the spiritual stature of Christ. This is why, the Major Superiors and the Rectors promote frequent formation meetings for all the religious, according to the possibilities and circumstances (*Constitutions and Norms*, 12/a).

Heart of Jesus, may you lead the bishops in their mission of teachers, fathers and shepherds of their Church.

August

For mutual coexistence.

Let us pray that societies where coexistence seems more difficult might not succumb to the temptation of confrontation for ethnic, political, religious or ideological reasons.

Cavanis:

In the Jubilee Year, we, religious, listen to the words of Fr. Mark that exhort us to hope: "May mutual charity unite us, the same spirit animate us, our vocation comfort us, may God's will guide us, his glory, the love for youth and then hope for every good blessing".

Heart of Jesus, may your priests be faithful shepherds and loving apostles for your people.

September

For our relationship with all of creation.

Let us pray that, inspired by Saint Francis, we might experience our interdependence with all creatures who are loved by God and worthy of love and respect.

Cavanis:

Let us pray that each of our educators will be committed to making people understand that it is the duty of all to take care of the world around us and support us because it is like taking care of ourselves: in this way, we are avoiding a culture of immediate consumerism, masked with noble claims that leads to war between us (*Fratelli Tutti*, 17).

Heart of Jesus, draw to your side the ministers who act in your name in the midst of your people.

October

For collaboration between different religious traditions.

Let us pray that believers in different religious traditions might work together to defend and promote peace, justice and human fraternity.

Cavanis:

We religious and the entire Christian community, "in front of the pluralism of cultures and the present-day complexity that characterize the crisis and the travail of the modern era, we are challenged and invited to a greater awareness of the historical-social situation by disposing ourselves to the behavior of listening, analysis and discernment" (from the Third Congress of the Church in Italy - 1995).

Heart of Jesus, may you give to priests assigned in mission countries the gift of faithfulness to their vocation of sacrifice and service.

November

For the prevention of suicide.

Let us pray that those who are struggling with suicidal thoughts might find the support, care and love they need in their community, and be open to the beauty of life.

Cavanis:

Let us pray with faith that relying on God so that the hope of salvation may sustain us in times of disorientation and sorrow, meditating on the prayer from the Psalm: "The Lord is a stronghold for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble. And those who know your name put their trust in you, for you, O Lord, have not forsaken those who seek you" (Psalm 9: 9-10).

Heart of Jesus, may the shepherds of your people look at your charity in order to learn how to give their life.



For Christians in areas of conflict.

Let us pray that Christians living in areas of war or conflict, especially in the Middle East, might be seeds of peace, reconciliation and hope.

Cavanis:

The religious should educate themselves and the youth to grasp the richness in the variety of cultures "The wickedness of man, fomented by false ideologies, it fails to recognize the fundamental dignity of each person, which merits unconditional respect regardless of ethnic origin or religious belief" (*Fratelli tutti*, 247).

Heart of Jesus, may you support the priests in the difficulties of their apostolate, so that they may hold on the grace they have received.
